Hoping to cash in on the frenzy of job seekers, the Club is currently looking for members in good standing to step up and take on the following jobs:

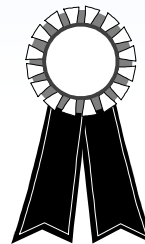
Adopt-A-Highway Coordinator:

1. Required to get NYS DOT training to run program and be designated Club contact.
2. Coordinate and submit dates for cleanups, up to 3 years with **NYS DOT**.
3. Instruct the NYS DOT training program for the Club at each cleanup.
4. Be responsible for the pickup and return of NYS DOT signs and equipment.
5. Make report to Club membership on latest activity at monthly meetings.



Fund Raising and Awards Chair:

1. Responsible for running the 50/50 raffle at the monthly Club meeting.
2. Responsible for the sale of all Club promotional items, sweat shirts, caps, etc.
3. Maintain inventory for promotional items and coordinate with **Treasurer** for supply.
4. Seek nominations for annual awards prior to last Club meeting of season.
5. Coordinate annually with the February formed **Election Committee** to include nominees for annual Club awards on the election ballot.
6. Coordinate all fund raising operations, including NYSSA annual raffle.
7. Report all expenditures and income from fund raising directly to **Treasurer**.

1. Manage the operation of the Trail Stewards program.

4. Coordinate with the **Fund Raising and Awards Chair** for any special awards.

Club News

Trail Closure?

Due to a landowner deciding to close a section of C7B in Mariaville, the entire trail from Duanesburg to the Montgomery County line may be without funding this season.

What does that mean to you the Club member? You will not be able to ride north from Duanesburg into the Town of Florida trails. You will not be able to get to Mariaville Lake or the businesses located there. You will not be able to get to Mariaville Motorsports on Rt. 30.

What does this closure mean to the Frontier Sno Riders? We could lose 12 miles of NYS trail funding. That is a serious loss for the Club.

We are hoping that the landowner will reconsider his position and allow us back onto his property. This will allow trail riding to continue in the Mariaville area.

The Club works very hard to keep trails open for the members, but sometimes things happen that we cannot change. The landowner's property is a vital link in the Club's trail system. We really need his cooperation and are willing to work with him in the future.

We hope that by the next newsletter, we have better news to report.

Trail Log

East Berne - Work continues to make the trail to Thacher Park a reality.

Knox - Work parties to begin shortly for trail brushing and clearing. Sign up at the next club meeting to help.

Esperance - More local volunteers are needed in this area. Come to the club meeting in East Berne to sign up.

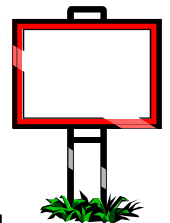

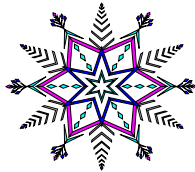
