### Tropical Storm Irene Creates Havoc

The effects of Tropical Storm Irene have been devastating to the local area. Homes, roads, and lives have been swept away by the storm rains.



Many volunteers have come to the aid of local residents. Together they are slowly working on bringing the hard hit areas back toward normal. Even the recovery of the snowmobile trails has begun.

Early assessments of the snowmobile trails within Frontier's area, are shocking. Most culverts and bridges have been washed away. Some of these fixtures having only been installed this summer.

There are about 25 bridges and 30 culverts along the trail system. To replace or repair many of these prior to the start of the season will be a huge task.

The Club is asking all members that are able to volunteer with rebuilding, to contact a trail boss. Not only will man power be needed, but building materials as well. A lot of lumber goes into a single bridge. Old trailer frames serve as excellent bridge frames. Do you know of one that could be donated to the club? How about heavy equipment? We need the donated use of dozers and track hoes.




Culvert newly repaired at Heldeberg Airport in East Berne.






Location of former bridge on S70 near Joslyn School Rd.




The bridge washed downstream from C7B near Maple Inn, East Berne.

### **Trail Work Is Starting Soon**

Your club needs your help, the trails are not ready due to the heavy rains of Tropical Storm Irene. Many bridges were washed away during the flooding and need to be replaced.

Over the last few years the Club has systematically replaced worn out or installed new bridges and culverts. Many of these bridges were built to carry the weight of the class B New Holland groomer the Club purchased in 2009. The bridges were made of steel frames with heavy wooden decking. They are now gone. This leaves the snowmobile trail fractured into many small segments, with no way to cross streams.

The bridges need to be replaced before the trails can open. Both manpower and materials will be in short supply. Please donate your time and or materials to help the club over come this major setback. Materials needed include old house trailer frames, rough cut lumber for decking, and culvert tubes of varying size. Please contact Brian Buchardt or Ron Shultes if you can help with this.



### **Grant Funding Update**

Phase I and II are complete and have been submitted to the town and county sponsors. Phase I deadline was June 15<sup>th</sup> and covers new and rerouted trails. It serves as a pre-approval step to Phase II. Phase II deadline was August 15<sup>th</sup>. A lot of hard work and long hours go into the grant funding process. A big thanks goes out to *Nancy Valletta* for getting this task completed! The Club should receive notification in September on the status of what trails will be funded and how much.
