

### **Bridge Replacements Underway**

**East Berne.** One of the club's many projects is up-grading some of the bridges to accommodate the bigger groomers. A good time to do this is when the decking is worn out and due for replacement.

The Turner Road bridge on trail C7B falls into this category. The original bridge built in 2012 was an old mobile home frame which worked well when the club was grooming with Skandics in the Berne/ Knox area.

Soon after the club was purchasing bigger groomers and they could not cross this bridge safely resulting in sometimes making a tricky creek

crossing. Groomers have to ford the stream when a bridge cannot support them. Ice ledges can be difficult to navigate and ice will form on the groomer from the cold water, then caking up with snow.

So after many years of planning and searching for a suitable bridge frame and when the old bridge needed replacing because

of a rotted deck, the club acquired a 42' steel framed trailer donated by Carver Industries.

A few years went by and finally we started to get the ball rolling and prep work began. The trailer frame had to be made ready for transportation to the site. One axle, the deck and any other non essentials were removed in late 2019.

Then we needed to wait for the ground to be clear and not too soft to get the frame out onto the site.


What follows here in photos is the process involved in replacing a bridge. The last phase of the job, planned for later this year, will be putting a new deck on the bridge.

### Power Line to get new poles

As reported in the Daily Gazette, LS Power Grid New York will be replacing about 1250 existing transmission poles with about 600 steel monopoles.

The lines pass through the northern area of Frontier Sno Riders trails C7E and C7B, in the towns of Glen, Charleston, and Florida.

Work may begin later this year or in early 2021. Construction will start at the Rotterdam end of the line and work westward. The line project should be in operation in 2023.

It is unknown how this replacement project will affect the snowmobile trails at this time. The club will comply with the company to maintain the crossing of the line property.


