

Charleston Bridge Being Built

Bridge replacement project is now underway by President Gerry Lenseth Ever wonder when you are riding through NYS's park forests how a sturdy bridge structure comes to exist in such remote areas? Well here is a look at a current DEC project underway right in our own back woods (or technically the Charleston State Forest) along the C7F Frontier Sno-Riders trail in Montgomery County.

A mid-winter bridge replacement project is now underway courtesy of the NYS DEC, our local Charleston Forester and a DEC construction crew based in Stamford, NY. The original request from our club came back in 2018 from the volunteers that cleared and widened the pre-existing "goat path" (actually a combination of hiking, skiing and horse paths) through miles and miles of lightly used dense forest. The clubs request was originally for the existing "foot bridge" to be replaced with a suitable 10' wide bridge to allow for Class A grooming equipment to cross the

creek. The FSR trail crew redirected the trail nearby the foot bridge to allow for better approach on either bank for sled and groomer traffic.

Following the close of the 2019 hunting season, clearing of the old bridge commenced and construction began with a tentative completion date this March. The current structure being installed at the foot bridge crossing will be just 6' in width which will limit grooming to either Skandic or UTV equipment at

best for the future over the bridge.

Cold winter temperatures and frozen ground typically allow for projects like this to be completed if the snow level is not deep, such as is the case this winter to date. This project involves the use of a

track hoe, articulated ATV rock truck, skidsteer (at nearby shale pit) and a UTV. Lumber, steel, gravel and shale are being toted in along the narrow trail to the work site. When the bridge is complete, the crew will dress the trail in reverse on the way out smoothing the terrain and removing stumps as needed.

Be cautious as you traverse the C7F trail north of Sara Libb Rd if the trails become open for the riding season and be on the lookout for the new bridge. In the meantime, our temporary club built water crossing structure is holding up well nearby for the season.

Although state projects tend to take time to complete, the club benefits from the improvement to the trail at little effort and cost from the club. We appreciate the opportunity to maintain our trail system through state land and look forward to utilizing the new bridge when complete.


