Trail funding from NYS department of Parks may very well be in jeopardy this year. Please help where you can for the health and viability of our future.

It was a very enjoyable and relaxing way to shake off the disruption of the past few months and regroup for the start of the new season. We look forward to working with each of you this year and riding the trails together when the snow flies!


