Thank you to all of our volunteers who worked so we could enjoy a well-maintained trail system throughout all four counties. This was a banner year for work, with several bridges rebuilt. Our volunteers work all year to maintain the trail system. These dedicated individuals do everything from tree trimming and brush hogging the trails to staking the routes, and maintaining the bridges.



President Gerry Lenseth coordinated a work party of 3 on March 6.




This section of trail needed a lot of work cutting back the brush to help get the big groomer through.


