

Duanesburg Airport Access To Close

Due to snowmobiles not staying on the marked corridor, the access along the runway will be closed off next season.


This will mean only one route to the Duanesburg Diner, Stewart's and Jonathan's to remain open.

Snowmobile tracks left behind tell the story of how trails get closed. When a rider chooses to ignore the signs and ride off trail, the trail may close.

The best thing a snowmobiler can do to help prevent trail closures is to stay on the marked trail.

Next season traveling to or from Jonathan's will require crossing both Rt 7 and 20 in the village. Great care will need to be taken while riding on pavement for a distance.

It only takes one to ruin it for all.


Of the 224 snowmobile clubs in NYSSA, only 4 cover three counties or more, and Frontier is one of only two that cover four counties!!

Trails Into Duanesburg

The green lines are the trails currently running into Duanesburg from C7B. The main trail is S70.

The area in red is not to be used for snowmobile traffic. Stay away from the US Post Office and the drive that runs between Rt7 and Rt20.

Next season the section of S70 running along side the runway will be closed due to snowmobiles riding off the marked trail.

Trail C7B At Blue Heron Airport In Jeopardy

Two snowmobile riders raced down the runway at Blue Heron Airport in the Town of Wright while the landowner and his family were there to witness the trespassing.

There are a number of signs warning against this activity in plain sight. Trail C7B will be closed at the airport if this happens again.

Trail C7B - Closed At Webster Rd, Update:

The Club continues to search for a route around the trail closure of C7B at Webster Road. Please do not ride the closed section of C7B. A barricade has been placed on both sides of Webster Road. It is dangerous to try and ride around the barricade, you could be injured. C7B no longer crosses Webster Road.






